

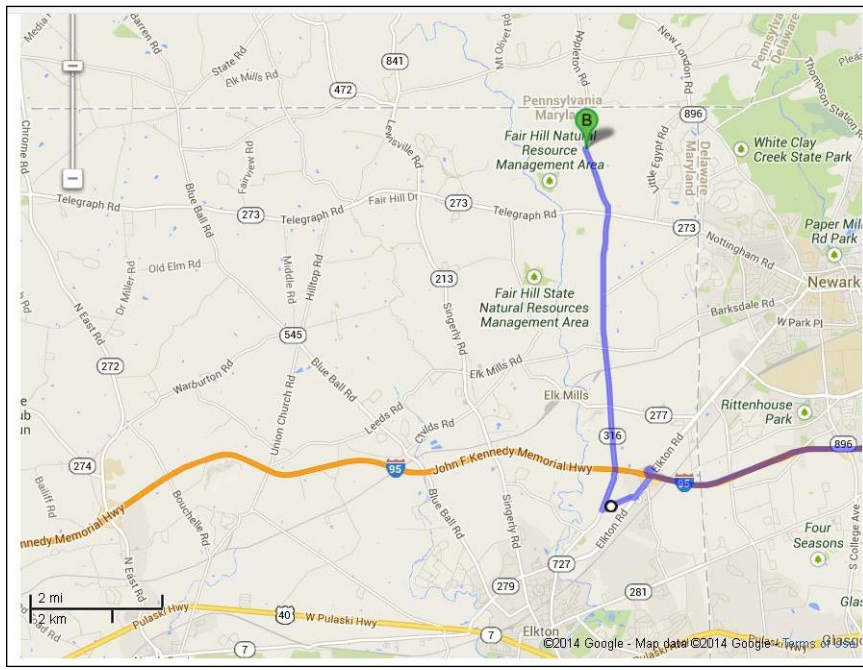
## Directions to Headquarters for Tracking Test

Fair Hill NRMA, 2895 Appleton Road, Elkton MD 21911

**From the South:** I-95 north to Exit 100 (North East). Turn left off ramp onto Route 272 north. Follow Route 272 North to Route 273. Turn right (east) on Route 273, drive for 8.8 miles. Turn left at the blinking light onto Appleton. Drive 1.2 miles and turn left into the parking lot marked Black Bridge Road and the sign "Fair Hill Natural Resources Management Area."

**From the North:** I-95 or NJ Turnpike south over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Exit 19A: Route 279 S towards Route 213 / Elkton Route 273. From the bottom of the ramp go straight under 0.5 miles and turn right at the traffic light onto Belle Hill Rd. Go 0.5 miles on Belle Hill Road to the stop sign and make a sharp Right turn on to Route 316 (Appleton Road). Follow Appleton Road 5.6 miles to test headquarters\* parking lot on the left.

After the turn from Belle Hill Road onto Appleton as you travel the 5.6 miles, you should pass the SOUTH Appleton Parking lot. Continue and CROSS OVER Telegraph Rd - Route 273 (blinking light). Continue on Appleton and then the tracking test headquarters will be on the left in the NORTH APPLETON parking lot.



**From the west:** Route 41 east. Turn right at the light in Cochranville onto Route 10. Go 0.9 miles. Turn Left onto Route 896 at the blinking light. Go 9.4 miles. In the village of Emblesville a huge yellow sign with a black arrow points left. Do NOT follow 896 left, GO STRAIGHT onto Appleton Road. Go 2.6 miles. Tracking test headquarters at the North Appleton Parking Lot #3 will be on the right.

**ENTRY FEE: TD \$75; TDU \$75; TDX \$135; VST \$150**

**CHECKS should be payable (in US Funds) to Oriole Dog Training Club (ODTC)**

**This is a combined test. ONLY ONE ENTRY per DOG is allowed.**

Certification forms must accompany entry forms for untitled dogs.

Dogs with tracking titles should include those titles with the dogs' names on the entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as a condition of acceptance. All cancellations must be written and received by the Test Secretary before the closing date. FAX, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

**PLEASE make your entries correct and legible.** Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Apply to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual exhibitor responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Track Trial. Fees are to be collected by the test-giving club and paid to the AKC.

**ENTRIES CLOSE:** Monday, March 28, at 5 pm after which time entries will not be accepted, can be altered, or substituted.

**THE CLUB MAY CANCEL** the event in the case of extreme weather conditions.

Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facility, grounds and / or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, a refund of entry will be made.

**ENTRIES WILL BE DRAWN** at the Secretary's address at 6 pm on Monday, March 28. All inter-parties are invited to attend the draw. Test Workers Option (Chapter 1, Section 17d) will be in effect. **One test workers' option will be set aside for each test.** If the number of entries exceeds the number of tracks there will be a draw at the test secretary's home: 16 Delaware Ave, Earleville MD 21919. **Untitled** dogs will have priority. If your dog earns his title before the test please notify the test secretary. Dogs with **neither** a TD nor TDU have preference for TDU & TD.

When the published limit has been reached, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on alternate lists, corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. In the event any of the accepted entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order in which they have been drawn. Alternates may accept or reject to exhibit. Entry fees will be refunded by mail to those alternates who do not participate. Entry fees will be refunded to accepted/drawn entries only if there is a valid alternate to run in their place. Exhibitors will be notified within 24 hours by e-mail or phone regarding the results of the draw.

**If the limit of entries in one test is not reached**, and is exceeded by the limits in another, for the purposes of this test, the number of tracks will be exchanged at a rate of **2 TD's = 1 TDX, 2 TDU's = 1 VST.**

**IN SEASON** may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulation. This section requires notification to the trial secretary prior to the drawing of tracks. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate only after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.

Rosette and a Tracking Patch will be awarded to each team that qualifies at the Oriole Dog Training Club's TD, TDU, TDX or VST Trial.

## About the Area

Fair Hill is a heavily used public park of 5,656 acres. Trackers are highly likely to encounter ATVs, bicycles, people with leashed dogs, cross-country runners, and hikers at the headquarters site and possibly on the tracks. The fields are cut for hay. Depending on the weather and mowing schedule, the grass could be high, raked, or closely mown.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not over 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth, wirehaired, colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a champion whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a champion.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show are registered. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show which entries closed after the date of the acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has a registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer of registration has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
5. Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
