
Directions to Headquarters for Tracking Test

om the South: I-95 north to Exit 100 (North East). Turn left off ramp onto Route 272 orth. Follow Route 272 North to Route 273. Turn right (east) on Route 273, drive for 8.8 les. Turn left at the blinking light onto Appleton. Drive 1.2 miles and turn left into the Irking lot marked Black Bridge Road and the sign "Fair Hill Natural Resources anagement Area."

om the North: I-95 or NJ Turnpike south over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Exit 19A: Route 279 S towards Route 213 / Elkton Route 273. From the bottom of the ramp go st under 0.5 miles and turn right at the traffic light onto Belle Hill Rd. Go 0.5 miles on Belle II Road to the stop sign and make a sharp Right turn on to Route 316 (Appleton 22). Follow Appleton Road 5.6 miles to test headquarters* parking lot on the left.

fter the turn from Belle Hill Road onto Appleton as you travel the 5.6 miles, you should ASS the SOUTH Appleton Parking lot. Continue and CROSS OVER Telegraph Rd - oute 273 (blinking light). Continue on Appleton and then the tracking test headquarters will on the left in the NORTH APPLETON parking lot.



rom the west: Route 41 east. Turn right at the light in Cochranville onto Route 10. Go .9 miles. Turn Left onto Route 896 at the blinking light. Go 9.4 miles. In the village of Lemblesville a huge yellow sign with a black arrow points left. Do NOT follow 896 left, GO TRAIGHT onto Appleton Road. Go 2.6 miles. Tracking test headquarters at the North appleton Parking Lot #3 will be on the right.

Certification forms must accompany entry forms for untitled dogs.

Dogs with tracking titles should include those titles with the dogs' names on the entry form

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collectio the amount of each returned check.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as acceptance. All cancellations must be written and received by the Test Secretary before the clos date. FAX, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not of AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the revers of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

PLEASE make your entries correct and legible. Illegible entries cannot be processed and wi returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Agents are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Apply Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6). Each Owner/Agent listed on the entry form and/or individua responsible for the dog at the show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the form.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Track Fees are to be collected by the test-giving club and paid to the AKC.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Monday, March 28, at 5 pm after which time entries will not be accepted, car altered. or substituted.

THE CLUB MAY CANCEL the event in the case of extreme weather conditions.

Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, heat, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the faciliting grounds and / or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health are of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectator paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before complication of entry will be made.

ENTRIES WILL BE DRAWN at the Secretary's address at 6 pm on Monday, March 28. All interparties are invited to attend the draw. Test Workers Option (Chapter 1, Section 17d) will be in e **One test workers' option will be set aside for each test.** If the number of entries exceeds the 4 tracks there will be a draw at the test secretary's home: 16 Delaware Ave, Earleville MD 21915 **Untitled** dogs will have priority. If your dog earns his title before the test please notify the test se Dogs with **neither** a TD nor TDU have preference for TDU & TD.

When the published limit has been reached, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position or alternate lists, corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. In the event any of the accept entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates order in which they have been drawn. Alternates may accept or reject to exhibit. Entry fees will be refunded by mail to those alternates who do not participate. Entry fees will be refunded to accepted/drawn entries only if there is a valid alternate to run in their place. Exhibitors will be no within 24 hours by e-mail or phone regarding the results of the draw.

If the limit of entries in one test is not reached, and is exceeded by the limits in another, for t purposes of this test, the number of tracks will be exchanged at a rate of 2 TD's = 1 TDX, 2 TDU's = 1 VST.

TCHES IN SEASON may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking gulation. This section requires notification to the trial secretary prior to the drawing of tracks. Bitches season will be allowed to participate only after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been sted.
