Dogs will be arranged in "Tall to Small" order.
Please include your jump height on your entry form.
Rally Ring will be no smaller than 40' by 50'.

RAE/RACH Entries: Please check the box on the entry form for RAE/RACH. Dogs entered in this class will be entered in Excellent B/Advanced B or Excellent B/Advanced B/Master. Once the limit has been reached in any class, entries will be returned in their entirety. RAE/RACH entries are eligible for the waiting list, but if *all* classes do not become available by closing, the multiple-class RAE/RACH entry will be returned and the next eligible waitlisted person will receive the slot.

WAIT LIST: A wait list will be kept to fill entries that are withdrawn prior to the closing date and time. Once the trial is closed and the limits have been reached, all entries on the wait list not accepted into the trial will be returned. There is no post-closing wait list.

TRANSFERS: Transfers will be allowed. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

****Do not**** send entries requiring a signature upon delivery. The secretary is not responsible for an entry received after the show closes due to a signature requirement.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees, or with post-dated or returned checks will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made via email as soon as practicable.

Please include legible e-mail address on your entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. Per Rally Regulations (Chapter 1, Section 4) recording fees are \$3.50 per first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry on the same dog.

Notice to Exhibitors

• POLICIES REGARDING WORKING ON THE ARTIFICIAL TURF ARENA

- * The following treats may be used on the turf: String cheese and slices of cheese, meat roll (non-crumbling), freeze dried treats, hot dogs, jerky treats, pupperoni, soft packaged treats (non-crumbling)
- * You may not use: Baby food, Braunschweiger, cheese puffs, cooked liver, cooked chicken, ground cooked meats, hard crunchy biscuits, popcorn, raw foods, yogurt.
- * You and your dog are required to pick up the treats from the turf.
- * **Please potty your dog often.** If there is an accident, there is a charge of \$5 to offset the cleaning of the turf.
- * Waterproof covering is required under crates and set-up areas.

• REFUND POLICY

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.

- **TRANSFERS:** Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Crating space is limited. No ex-pens. No unentered dogs, please. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exhibitors providing email addresses may receive all communication, including confirmation and judging schedule through email.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering.
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
