NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

POLICIES REGARDING WORKING ON THE ARTIFICIAL TURF ARENA

Acceptable treats to use on the turf: string cheese, meat roll (non-crumbling), freeze dried treats, hot dogs, jerky treats, Pup-Peroni, soft packaged treats (non-crumbling).

--Unacceptable treats: baby food, Braunschweiger, cheese puffs, cooked liver or chicken, ground cooked meats, hard crunchy biscuits, popcorn, raw foods, yogurt.
--You and your dog are required to pick up the treats from the turf.
--There is a charge of \$5 for accidents on the turf to offset the cost of cleaning.
--Waterproof covering is required under crates and set-up areas.

The American Kennel Club (AKC) Rules and Regulations will govern this Trial and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the entry form in this Premium List

No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
Signature is required. Unsigned entries and entries received without payment will not be accepted. Note: Entry Forms without the full AKC Agreement and Rules and signature will not be accepted.

ODTC assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or the owner's agent. ENTRANTS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETENESS AND ACCURACY OF ALL INFORMATION ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Club will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Refunds (minus an administration fee of \$5.00 per class) for bitches in season will be mailed to the Exhibitor after the conclusion of the trial if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made.

Entries will be acknowledged via email as they are received and processed. PLEASE VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF YOUR ENTRY INFORMATION as soon as you receive the processing email.

Confirmation and armband number will be sent via email after entries close. Those without an email address will be mailed by USPS to the address on the entry form.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE – Both the Trial Committee and the show site owner will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Trials. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is solely the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

COVID-19 Social Distancing Plan
Oriole Dog Training Club (ODTC)

AKC Rally & Obedience Trials – August 26, 27 & 28, 2022

As of the publication of this premium, ODTc is following the State of Maryland's recommendations with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic. Adjustments to this Plan will be made as needed should the State of Maryland and /or the AKC require any changes. Any updates to this Plan will be sent to exhibitors along with the judging program. Everyone who attends these trials is covered by this Plan as outlined below.

Any person who fails to follow this Plan and maintain at least six feet between individuals at all times during this event or on the show grounds during show hours may result in expulsion from this event.

NOTE: Due to the COVID situation at the time of the trials, indoor crating *may not be feasible*. You will be notified as soon as possible if any changes are necessary.

1. WHEN TO STAY HOME – You should NOT attend the trial if you cannot answer YES to the following question on the waiver you will be asked to sign on the day of the trial: *“To the best of my knowledge, I am not infected with the virus SARS-CoV-2 or any other virus known to cause the disease currently referred to as COVID-19. I also state that I am free of symptoms of such infection including: **FEVER, COUGH, SHORTNESS OF BREATH, AND/OR PERSISTENT PAIN/PRESSURE IN THE CHEST.** I have also not to my knowledge been in direct contact with anyone diagnosed with **SARS-CoV-2/COVID-19/Coronavirus** in the last 14 days nor have I been at any large event gathering where proper social distancing and masks were not enforced within the last 14 days”*. Please text the event secretary if you are unable to attend (Debbie Kaminski – 410-917- 3775) and at that point, you will be refunded 50% of your entry fee. Anyone who attends a public gathering must recognize they will always be at a risk that they could contract COVID-19 despite all the precautions that will be taken to reduce that risk.

2. FACE MASKS – at the present time, masks are **REQUIRED** of everyone **AT ALL TIMES** while in the building, regardless of vaccination status. Your mask must cover your nose, mouth, and chin to protect others. Please bring extra masks with you (ODTC will not be providing masks). While outside in the parking lot, a mask is not required provided you maintain a 6-foot distance from others.

3. DOG EXERCISE AREA – Dogs must be on leash at all times, both inside and outside the building, except when being shown in the ring. Maintain at least the required six feet of distance while you are exercising/warming up your dog outside the building and in the potty area. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of dog waste in the receptacles located in the exercise area.

4. CRATING – indoor crating available. **PLEASE BRING A CLEAN, WATERPROOF TARP TO PLACE UNDERNEATH YOUR CRATE AND SETUP AREA.**

5. PERSONAL CHAIRS will only be allowed in your crating area. **Chairs may not be setup at ringside.**

6. LUNCH will be on your own for all exhibitors. No food or beverages (other than water) are allowed in the arena.

7. PHOTOGRAPHER/VIDEOGRAPHER and VENDORS – Will not be present at these trials.

8. TRIAL CANCELLATION - ODTc reserves the right to cancel this trial at any time. Should that happen, any checks for trial entry fees will be shredded.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience & Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION.
