Please read!

We want you to know what to expect before entering.

- As of the publishing of this premium, we expect the trial to go on as described. All trial decisions will be in accordance with Maryland state and local guidelines in place at the time of the trial.
- Oriole Dog Training Club is making every effort to provide a safe trial environment. However, exhibitors are entering and attending the trial at their own risk.
- **NOTE: LATE Closing date is Wednesday, January 18, 2023 at 6:00 PM.**
- As of the publishing of this premium, we expect indoor crating to be allowed.
- Social distancing guidelines should still be followed as much as possible with people outside your immediate social circle. This includes interactions with judge, volunteers, club members and other exhibitors. Masks may be required, but the policy will be detailed in the judging program for the event. We will follow state/local guidelines at the time of the trial.
- Paper course maps will not be available. Course maps will be displayed. As of October 1, AKC is no longer allowing course maps to be supplied to exhibitors the day before the trial. (We may be able to publish course maps the “day of”, and we will supply more information on course maps in the judging schedule.) In any case, you should come prepared to photograph the map for your personal use.
- You may check your dog in on the gate sheets. **NOTE: Only the gate steward can make changes to the running order.**
- Food will not be available onsite. Plan on bringing your own lunch, water, drinks, ice, etc.
- Ribbons will be self-serve. Results will be posted and will be emailed individually to exhibitors after the trial.
- AKC is allowing exhibitors to run with leashes in pocket (must fit fully) or wear them when running course. Don't drop it!
- Exhibitors are expected to follow state, local government, event and facility guidelines. Full details will be included in the judging schedule.

Oriole Dog Training Club is offering FEO at this set of trials.

Measuring and Height Card Information

Exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a box on the form for exhibitors to designate whether their dog needs to be officially measured. Please indicate (by checking the box) if your dog needs to be on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program. PAL/ILP/Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered in order to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Fix and Go / FEO / Entering Mixture of Height Information

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by Oriole Dog Training Club.

All classes will take place indoors on **Sprinturf**®. Ring size will be 90' x 93' with 3 pillars in the ring. Electronic timers will be used.

Course Walk-throughs and Warm-Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Please make every effort to walk with an "earlier" group to ensure the smooth running of the trial and timely results for each height division.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green Ribbon

A rosette will be offered to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.

A bar will be offered to dog/handler teams who finish their MACH, PACH or PAX.

A ribbon will be given for a perfect score not earned in the Master classes.

A ribbon will be given for a double-Q earned from the Master class.

After Closing Waiting List

Entry Information

Confirmation of entry, move-up or cancellation will be sent via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard with your entry. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline or entry cancellation by the closing date/time, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their e-mail address is legible and that messages will be accepted from agilitysec@clantyre.net.

Entries open December 7, 2022 (8 a.m.) at the Trial Secretary's address and will be limited to 125 runs on Friday, 350 runs per day on Saturday and Sunday. The method of entry is **First Received**. The closing date is January 18, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. No hand deliveries for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.

Entry fees are \$20 per run per day. (Includes AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry per dog per day. Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.)

Junior Handler discounted fees: \$10 per run per day. Junior Handler name and AKC JH number must be included on the entry form. Dogs must be run by the Junior Handler listed on the form. If the dog is run by a handler other than the entered Junior, the regular entry fee must be paid to the Secretary prior to the dog's run.

Make checks payable (in US funds) to Clantyre Show Secretary Services.

Express Mail entries *must* include signature permitting them to be left without recipient signature.

Online / Credit Card Entries

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: Fifty percent (50%) of entries per day available for online entry, fifty percent (50%) of entries per day for paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Online Entries will receive a confirming email from LabTestedOnline which will be considered the initial entry confirmation. All changes to online entries before closing **MUST** be done through the online entry website to ensure that payment is correct. Final confirmation will be received from the Trial Secretary at closing.

PLEASE MAKE YOUR ENTRIES LEGIBLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owners/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards **do not** constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. (Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY bases.)

Refund Policy*

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The Club will refund all but ten(\$10.00) dollars per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season. The same refund will be given for any entered dog where a veterinarian determines that the dog should not run because of a medical condition. The same refund will be given where a medical doctor determines that the handler should not participate.

Full refund will be made for deceased dogs provided notification is made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial. No vet note required.

All notes must be signed, dated after the closing date, on official business letterhead, state the reason that the dog/handler may not compete and presented to the Trial Secretary by the end of the trial on Sunday. Please note: Phone calls, "text only" e-mails, and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. Vet notes may not be written by owner, handler or immediate family member.

*Clubs must list in the premium all situations for which they will provide a refund. (AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 9.) Refunds will not be made for any circumstance other than those listed above. Clubs/Trial Chairs/Trial Secretaries cannot make exceptions or honor refund requests for situations not listed.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

This trial may have special Covid-19 restrictions and requirements. If so, details will be published in the judging schedule for the event.

At the time of the publishing of this premium, we expect that crating WILL be allowed indoors.

The building will open at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, and 6:45 a.m. each day on Saturday and Sunday.

Oriole Dog Training Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Food will NOT be available on-site. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on site.

Recording/videoining for personal use is not prohibited as long as it does not obstruct aisles/walkways, disturb other exhibitors, dogs, or judge(s). Those using video must be cognizant of both intentional and ambient audio. These devices may not be used near the trial secretary/judge/club working areas or placed behind timer/scribe working in the ring.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ODTC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, illness or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

Move-Up Information

Per Chapter 1, Section 20, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials: Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00 p.m. on the Monday preceding the set of trials.

Move-ups may be e-mailed, mailed or faxed. Verbal move ups will not be accepted. Please include basic (legible) information: Owner's name, dog's registered name and call name, registration number, class change information. Confirmation of move-up will be sent via e-mail. If you have not received a confirmation of move-up by the Monday move-up deadline, please contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Day-to-day move ups will be allowed between the trial dates and will be taken up to one-half hour after the conclusion of the last class each day. These move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
