Lease Update for 9 Azar Court


A new 5-year lease has recently been signed for our building, committing the Club to 9 Azar Court through 2028.

As warehouse space like ours is in short supply in the Baltimore Metro region, costs per square foot have skyrocketed. Our new lease is no exception; the Club will incur <u>an increase of over 40% in the next 5 years</u>. Most of this increase will be effective on October 1, 2024.

It is important for members to also understand that since we moved into 9 Azar Court in 2014, our lease costs have <u>already risen 63%</u>, not including the increases in recently signed extension. While the Club has been able to absorb prior lease increases without substantially increasing fees, that is no longer possible.

Many actions will need to be taken to address the new financial reality. The current Board priority is evaluating the Club's Class Fees in conjunction with suggestions made by the Future Committee. You'll be hearing more about this as the Board completes its review and schedules a General Meeting to discuss this topic.

While cost escalations of 40% and 63% seem concerning, the Board and Future Committee are both confident that we will be able to proactively adjust Club operations and continue to thrive.

Perhaps you'd like some tips on how to do these more independently with your dog or at a greater distance? Come prepared to take your fancy skills to the next level! This seminar is for all levels. Distance & Discrimination Challenges

This seminar will help improve obstacle commitment from a distance, understanding of a dog's path and your parallel line, as well as the timing of your motion and verbals. If not, or you'd like to brush up on your skills, then this workshop is for you!
